

**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING  
BEFORE THE PLANNING AND ZONING COMMISSION AND  
CITY COUNCIL  
OF THE CITY OF ROWLETT, TEXAS**

NOTICE is hereby given that the Planning and Zoning Commission and City Council of the City of Rowlett, Texas will hold a public hearing at 6:30 p.m. on the 22nd day of March, 2016, and the City Council will hold a public hearing at 7:30 p.m. on the 5th day of April, 2016, both at the Municipal Center, 4000 Main Street, Rowlett, Texas.

At such time and place, the Commission and Council will hear testimony and take appropriate action on a request for a rezoning from Single Family-40 Zoning District to a Planned Development District with an underlying Single Family-5 (SF-5) base zoning district to build a single family subdivision. The minimum lot size for the proposed development is 6,000 square feet. The subject properties are located at 2009, 2013, 2109 and 2113 Miller Road further described as being 8.4 +/- acres in the S.A. & M.G. RR Survey, Abstract No. 1407, City of Rowlett, Dallas County, Texas.

All interested citizens of the City are invited to attend these public hearings and participate in same. Any owner of property subject to a proposed rezoning or affected by the proposed rezoning may protest the rezoning by filing a written protest with the Director of Planning. The protest must be received by the Planning Division by 5 pm on Wednesday, March 16, 2016, to be included in the Planning and Zoning Commission packet and Wednesday, March 30, 2016, to be included in the City Council packet. Responses received after March 30<sup>th</sup> shall not be counted in the record of response. The protest shall object to the rezoning, contain a legal description of the property on behalf of which the protest is made, and be signed by the owner of the property. If protests in the form of opposition are received from property owners within 200 feet of the subject property, and the property owners own a combined minimum of 20 percent or more of the land area, approval by the city council shall only occur with a concurring vote of at least three-fourths of the full membership of the city council.
